

CCAF International Legislative Oversight Program: GHANA

The CCAF partnership with the Ghana Audit Service (GAS)

The GAS (Ghana's supreme audit institution, or SAI) has been conducting performance audits since 2002 and made significant progress during CCAF's previous five-year program (2007-2012). The ILOP is assisting the GAS to further improve the quality of its performance audits and to increase the impact of its audit reports. There is a strong team of CCAF graduate Fellows at the office, who are leaders in performance auditing and environmental auditing. Several of the graduate Fellows have been recognized as AFROSAI-E champions and now often co-facilitate regional performance audit workshops. CCAF is also assisting the GAS in the integration of strategic planning, operational planning, performance measurement and reporting on its performance.

Workshops for the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) are continuing under the ILOP. CCAF held one workshop in 2014 and will deliver more training in the context of the upcoming December 2016 election. The SAI's performance audit reports are being tabled in parliament and reviewed by the PAC.

Background on CCAF and the International Legislative Oversight Program

CCAF-FCVI Inc. (formerly called the Canadian Comprehensive Auditing Foundation) is a non-profit research and educational organization that promotes effective performance audit and oversight of government operations. CCAF's International Legislative Oversight Program aims to contribute to improved transparency, effectiveness and accountability in public resource management in four countries: Cameroon, Ghana, Tanzania and Vietnam. The program runs from 2012 to 2017. It builds upon the success of our previous five-year program (the International Legislative Audit Assistance Program, 2007-2012) and CCAF's history of international engagement, which dates to 1980.

The program's principal activities are Fellowships (for senior auditors) and internships (for SAI managers) in Canada; in-country and regional workshops; online distance education courses; support for SAI management on matters such as performance measurement and strategic planning; and ongoing mentoring and follow-up. Participants in the nine-month Fellowships are required to develop performance audit plans that they will conduct when they return from Canada. Participants in the 3-module training program delivered with AFROSAI-E are required to plan, conduct and report performance audits. Activities are delivered with our many Canadian partners—federal, provincial and municipal audit offices that share their expertise by volunteering to be Fellowship hosts, training co-facilitators, and mentors.
