#### **AUDIT NEWS DATABASE**

A valuable tool for performance audit professionals, the *Audit News* database, updated monthly, gives access to thousands of performance audit reports and related documents published by audit institutions in Canada and abroad over the last 10 years. This database and its search engine provide members with a one-stop shop for publicly available audit documentation that allows them to rapidly find what auditors from various jurisdictions have previously done on numerous topics of interest.



#### PERFORMANCE AUDIT GUIDANCE INVENTORY

CAAF's *Performance Audit Guidance Inventory* is a unique compilation of audit guidance documents published by over 55 legislative audit offices from around the world over the past decade. The guidance documents are presented under 22 different thematic categories and links are provided to rapidly access each document. The *Inventory* is updated every six months.
